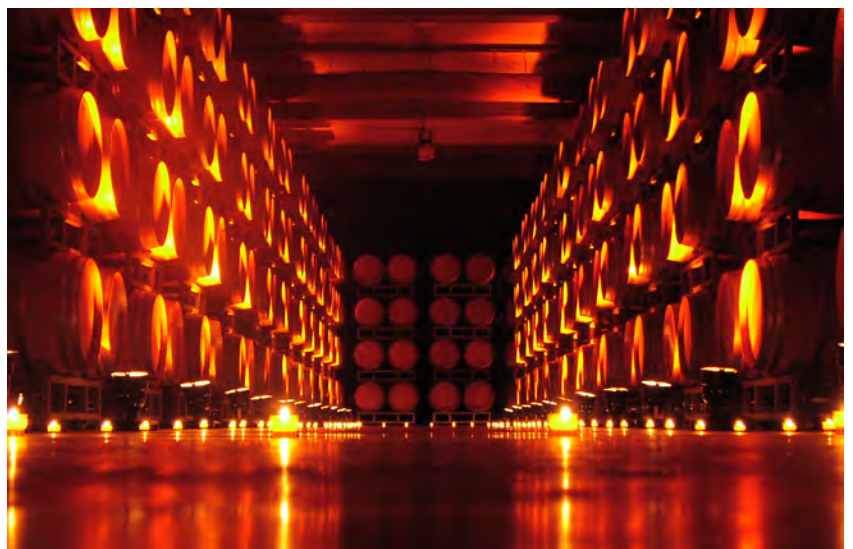

01-010 Bois Royal 2022

£12.99

Grapes: Merlot, Cabernet Franc

Juicy merlot-based Bordeaux red with hints of toast, cedar, blackberries and plums. Excellent tasty claret at a great price! GOLD MEDAL WINNER Berliner Wine Trophy 2020. Alc 13.5%

01-012 Vallon d'Arche 2022

£11.99

Grapes: Merlot, Cabernet Franc

Vibrant, juicy Merlot dominated red with hints of toast, cedar, plum & black cherry. "87/100. This is a ripe, textured wine, full of jammy Merlot as well as a light burden of tannins. An edge of fruitiness shows well and balances the dry core." (Wine Enthusiast 01.08.20.) Alc 13.5%

01-080 Chateau Vieux Barrail 2020

£13.99

Grapes: Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon & Cabernet Franc.

Elegant notes of dried cranberry, dried herbs & pomegranate with a velvety, dry-yet-fruity medium-full body & a warming, compelling, medium-long finish evoking shades of charcuterie, forest fruits & subtle oak flavour. Alc: 13%

MEDOC

01-145-15 Chateau Tour de By 2016

£30.99

Grapes: 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 35% Merlot, 5% Petit Verdot

The Grand Vin comes from beautiful gravelly plots, located 200 metres from the Gironde. It is a wine full of elegance and finesse, with a lot of freshness and intense fruit. With a beautiful tannic structure, it can age for up to 20 years. Alc 13%



SAINT-ESTEPHE

01-030-17 Chateau Tour des Termes 2017

£30.99

Grapes: 60% Merlot, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc and 5% Petit Verdot

Château Tour des Termes takes its name from an old tour, or tower, located on a vineyard plot called Les Termes. The origin of this tower dates back to Gallo-Roman times. The name “des Termes” means “the end of the land”. Rich red and black fruit with hints cinnamon and clove from the well integrated oak. Good concentration on the palate with an elegant and long finish.

Enjoy with red and white meats, game, Brie and Camembert cheeses.

01-130-19 Chateau les Ormes de Pez 2019

£40.99

Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot

With its deep garnet colour, Chateau Ormes de Pez offers fresh cherry and black fruit aromas with big, well-rounded tannins and a lingering freshness. A harmoniously balanced blend of Cabernet and Merlot. Alc 14.5%

PAUILLAC

01-095-19 Chateau Pedesclaux Fleur de Pedesclaux 2019

£29.99

Grapes: 59% Cabernet Sauvignon, 36% Merlot, 3% Petit Verdot, 2% Cabernet Franc

Fleur de Pédesclaux is a delight. In the mouth, it is fresh, subtle, packed with fruit and beautifully smooth tannins, with a long finish.

“90/100...matured in 30% new oak, has been increasing its Cabernet Sauvignon since 2009, when it was pure Merlot (and also undergoing organic conversion since 2013). Raspberry, blackberry, cedar, and light tobacco scents unfurl in the glass. The palate is still quite fleshy & rounded, & lightly spiced, retaining that hint of Chinese five spice toward the tender finish. A lovely second wine. 2023-2033.” (Neal Martin, Vinous, Dec 2021) Alc 13.5%

01-065-20 La Croix des Aubrais 2021

£32.99

Grapes: 45% Cabernet Sauvignon, 35% Merlot, 12% Cabernet Franc, 8% Petit Verdot

La Croix des Aubrais comes from vines that are over 30 years old. The bespoke care given to the vinification and maturing process ensures a perfect balance between power and elegance. The quality of this wine is constant from one vintage to the next, and it is in line with the great wines of the appellation. The intense nose reveals notes of black fruits, aromas of truffle, blackcurrant and woody cedar. The palate is round and powerful supported by tasty tannins that offer a very good balance of flavours to end on a silky and long finish. Alc 13%

01-115-17 Chateau Bellegrave 2017**£40.99**

Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot

"92/100. The vineyard of Bellegrave in the southern part of Pauillac has produced a softly textured wine in this lighter vintage. With hints of maturity and black-currant fruits that have mellowed well, the wine is almost ready to drink. Just wait until 2022." (Roger Voss, Wine Enthusiast, 01.09.21.) Alc 13%

01-230-09 Chateau Mouton Rothschild 2009**£1,099.00**

Grapes: Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon & Cabernet Franc

"99/100..bold earthy notions of underbrush, tilled soil and fungi over a core of crème de cassis, plum preserves and Indian spices with a waft of camphor. Full-bodied with a firm, velvety tannin texture and packed with black fruit preserves and exotic spice layers, it has seamless freshness and a very long, decadently fruited finish. 2020 - 2060" (Parker's Wine Advocate, Mar 2019)

SAINT-JULIEN

1722 - Thomas Barton left his native Ireland to settle in Bordeaux, founding a wine merchant company. 1826 - His grandson, Hugh Barton, purchased 50 hectares of vines located in the Saint Julien appellation. In the historic 1855 classification the chateau was to be awarded the rank of "Second Classified Growth". The property was managed by the various generations over the years until Anthony Barton raised Château Léoville Barton to the level of international recognition it enjoys today. The Barton story continues with his daughter, Lilian, and her two children, now writing the chapter of the 10th generation.

01-310-19 La Reserve de Leoville Barton 2019**£44.99**

Grapes: 74% Cabernet Sauvignon, 22% Merlot, 4% Cabernet Franc

This second wine of Chateau Léoville Barton comes from young vines and plots that have not reached the high level of requirement to enter in the Grand Vin. The wine is then aged between 16 and 18 months in French oak barrels. The intense nose develops notes of red fruits and licorice with a subtle woody note. Beautiful fullness and depth in the mouth, with fine and melted tannins. This wine presents a nice balance between power and finesse.

01-300-14 Chateau Leoville Barton 2014**£119.99**

Grapes: 83% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot, 2% Cabernet Franc

A stream of cherries, raspberries and grapefruit... Opulent and rich but with a glamour and class side, wrapped in a lace dress, extremely fine.

Wine Enthusiast 96, Jane Anson 96, Decanter 94. Alc 13.5%

01-300-15 Chateau Leoville Barton 2015**£159.99**

Grapes: 86% Cabernet Sauvignon, 14% Merlot

Intense colour, the nose is full of aromas of black fruit, spice and cedar.

The palate is fresh and balanced, the juice is intense and delicate.

01-009-13 Chateau Langoa Barton 2013**£59.99**

Grapes: 65% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Merlot, 5% Cabernet-Franc

Very expressive nose with some notes of raspberry, blackberry and violet.

In mouth, the wine is elegant, round and smooth. Juicy with fresh red fruits.

Long finish very fruity.

01-009-06 Chateau Langoa Barton 2006**£90.99**

Grapes: 65% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc

"91/100. Shows violet and blackberry, with hints of raisin. Full and velvety, with lovely-textured tannins and plenty of ripe fruit on the finish. Balanced and rich." (Wine Spectator) Alc 12.5%**01-135-14 Chateau Leoville Poyferre 2014****£149.99**

Grapes: 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 35% Merlot, 2% Petit Verdot, 3% Cabernet Franc

This Saint-Julien displays an intense garnet color with purple highlights. It is limpid and bright. Upon aeration, the nose reveals subtle, delicious fragrances of black cherry, blackberry, and delicate, well-integrated oak.

A hint of liquorice brings an enticing note of freshness. The attack is lively, plump and mouth filling. Beautifully balanced, the tannins are fine-grained.

Aromas of black fruit and delicate oak persist on the harmonious finish.

LISTRAC - MEDOC

01-032-19 Chateau Fourcas Hosten 2019

£30.99

50 % Cabernet Sauvignon, 48 % Merlot, 1 % Petit Verdot, 1 % Cabernet Franc
The palate is rich and concentrated, with aromas of blackberry jam and blackcurrant. It has a broad structure supported by rounded and supple tannins. Intense, balanced and fresh on the finish.

"93/100. Very pretty plum, light spice and dried-flower character on the nose, following through to a medium body with creamy and refined tannins. Bright acidity at the end. This only needs a few years to come together and deliver a beautiful glass. Try after 2023." James Suckling – Décembre 2021

MOULIS EN MEDOC

01-490-19 L'Impression de Mauvesin Barton 2019

£19.99

Grapes: 46% Merlot, 44% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Cabernet Franc

L'Impression de Mauvesin Barton" is the second wine of Chateau Mauvesin Barton. It comes from the young vines. The wine is aged in French oak barrels for 12 months. The barrels used are mainly those which already have received at least one wine.

The nose is very expressive and intense, with spicy notes, white pepper and a touch of strawberry jam. Beautiful structure, supple and greedy wine with immediate drinkability. Finishes with "little rolling tannins". Alc: 13%

01-016-19 Chateau Mauvesin Barton 2019

£29.99

Grapes: 64% Merlot, 27% Cabernet Sauvignon, 9% Cabernet Franc

The vineyard is situated in the "Moulis-en-Médoc" appellation, to the north of Bordeaux, on the left bank of the Gironde estuary.

Intense purple colour. Nose with subtle woody notes and red fruit, strawberry. Slight freshness on the palate from the start, with an already promising structure. Great pleasure.

MARGAUX

01-020-19 Blason d'Issan 2020

£36.99

Grapes: 40% Cabernet Sauvignon, 57% Merlot, 3% Petit Verdot
Blason d'Issan, the second wine of Chateau d'Issan. Fruit from the youngest vines is used to produce this wine, which respects the identity of its terroir, while offering a tasty round fruitiness, which can be enjoyed earlier. Blason d'Issan is also aged in barrels for 14 to 16 months, one third of which are new. The estate's team, together with Eric Boissenot were present when the vintage was blended on 6th January, and the result is a true revelation. With its subtle aromas and moreish fruit, the 2020 vintage is a fine expression of the quintessential Margaux terroir. Precision combines with elegance to reveal an explosion of flavour. Its delicate, harmonious tannins envelop the palate, then give way to a long, hedonistic finish. What a sumptuous vintage.

Grapes: 68% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Merlot, 5% Petit Verdot, 2% Cabernet Franc
Chateau Ferriere 2018, is a rich wine, with a beautiful muscular intensity. A texture that remains very silky, with round and integrated tannins. A beautiful vivacity on the palate. Try with Lamb or caramelised onion tart. 1 to 2 hours decanting time 16 to 18°C serving temperature.

01-460-09 Chateau Margaux 2009

Grapes: Merlot, Cabernet Franc
"98+/100" (Vinous). "98/100. The 2009 Château Margaux is deep garnet in color and features wonderfully fragrant minted cassis, lilacs, Black Forest cake and oolong tea scents with touches of pencil shavings and dusty soil. Medium to full-bodied, it has a firm, grainy frame with lovely freshness lifting the perfumed fruit to a very long, mineral-laced finish. 2020 - 2050" (Lisa Perrotti-Brown, Parker's Wine Advocate, 14th Mar 2019). PESSAC-LEOGNAN

01-119-18 Chateau Couhins 2018

Grapes: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, and Petit Verdot
Chateau Couhins Rouge possesses the characteristics of a great Pessac-Leognan wine: finesse, length, and a perfect balance between the tannic framework and the delectability of the grapes. Limited use of cask maturation, with 12 months ageing in less than 30% new oak barrels, encourages the clear expression of fruit.

"93/100. EDITOR'S CHOICE. This wine is richly endowed with dark tannins and swathes of ripe black fruits. Dry with a dense tannic character, the wine has a good future. The black fruits and rich structure promise much." (Roger Voss, Wine Enthusiast 01.04.21.) Alc 14.5%

01-100-16 Domaine de Chevalier 2016

Grapes: 55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 35% Merlot, 5% Petit Verdot, 5% Cabernet Franc

"97/100. Aromas of blackberries, red and dark plums, cedar and gravel, as well as red flowers and brown-leaf tea. It offers a very sleek and powerful array of ripe dark fruit and a very plush, focused and elegant bed of fresh, fine and powerful tannins." (James Suckling) Alc: 13.5%

01-120-18 Chateau Pape Clement 2018

£139.99

Grapes: 66% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Merlot, 4% Cabernet Franc

"With their smoky and spicy bouquet, the red wines are of an admirable quality and a very characteristic softness. The wine is both concentrated, fine and harmonious, with an aromatic palette as wide as it is precise. The depth and length in the mouth are exceptional. Quality of the terroir, sustained efforts and dynamism have borne fruit bringing Pape Clement to a level very close to that of the premiers crus." - Figaro Vin

CASTILLON

01-025-18 Chateau Montlandrie 2018

£39.99

Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon

A beautiful wine showing rich blackberry, cherry and plum fruit, with notes of licorice, dark chocolate and truffle. Concentrated and balanced with a long finish. 92/100 Decanter 92/100 Wine Advocate. Alc 14.5%

SAINT-EMILION

01-050 Chateau du Basque 2020, St Emilion Grand Cru Classe £21.99

Grapes: Merlot, Cabernet Franc

Owned by the Lafaye family. This 12 Hectare vineyard plot has mature 35-40 year old vines. This Grand Cru displays exotic plum and ripe blackberry fruit. Sweet juicy tannins, spicy cinnamon, cedar oak and a lively acidity complete the picture. "90/100. A spicy, wood-aged wine with layers of Merlot and a touch of Cabernet Franc. The wine is rich, still young with firm tannins and smoky acidity." (Wine Enthusiast Sept 2023) Alc 14%

01-014-20 Chateau Tour de Yon 2020, St Emilion Grand Cru Classe £34.99

Château Tour de Yon is located just a few yards from the famous Château Yon Figeac. Old vines, low yields, harvest done by hand, new oak and meticulous sorting, result in sumptuous blends, that rivals many more illustrious names. An elegant, balanced and attractive wine with crisp fruit, a pure and complete palate and good length. The large amount of new oak supports and complements the concentrated fruit.

"96/100. GOLD MEDAL. Dark, rich, fragrant black fruit, balanced with mocha, clove, black pepper, and dried herbs. Racy acidity gives a lively edge, with fine tannins and a long engaging finish. 75% Merlot, 25% Cabernet Franc." (Decanter World Wine Awards 2023) Alc: 14%

01-018-21 Chateau Pavie Macquin Premier Grand Cru Classe 2021 £119.99

Grapes: 79% Merlot, 19% Cabernet Franc, 2% Cabernet Sauvignon

The terroir of strong clay on limestone bedrock produces a powerful, fleshy wine with minerality, freshness and generosity.

"94/100. Beautifully poised, dark ruby in colour, full of rippled fruit flavours, stands out in the appellation. It hasn't got miraculously riper than all the rest but it is handled with skill, and has a truly juicy mouthwatering finish and slate tannins that show grip and tenacity against the serious, austere structure. Expect raspberry, greengage and redcurrant fruits that need to fatten out a little over ageing, but everything is in place to do so. This is the plateau speaking." SAINT GEORGE-SAINTE-EMILION

01-055 Chateau Labattut 2023

£17.99

Grapes: 70% Merlot, 28% Cabernet Sauvignon & 2% Cabernet Franc
Planted on the southern slopes of the Saint-Georges Saint-Emilion appellation (smallest Saint Emilion satellite). 12-14 months in oak. Notes of baked cherries, mulberries and fresh plums with touches of cedar chest, pencil shavings and bay leaves. Medium-bodied, chewy, great intensity of vibrant, youthful fruit to match. Alc: 14%

POMMEROL

01-140-20 Chateau Vieux Maillet 2020

£52.99

Grapes: 85% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Franc, 5% Cabernet Sauvignon
"92-94/100. a gorgeous wine. Bright, perfumed aromatics give Vieux Maillet striking aromatic presence that is so alluring. Deceptive in it's mid weight feel, Vieux Maillet is deep, potent and so expressive. Black cherry, lavender, spice, menthol. licorice & blood orange all build in the glass. Vibrant and wonderfully nuanced, the 2020 is compelling." (Vinous, May 2021) Alc 14.5%

01-015-19 Chateau Rouget 2019

£64.99

Grapes: 80% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Franc
The depth of the ruby red colour indicates an wide and generous wine. At first, the bouquet is all about black fruits and opens out on very soft and sweet spices.
The freshness of the mouth and the finesse of the tannins make the wine very silky, and the crunchy mouth in the middle will be quite surprising . It is a lively wine that will reveal itself a little bit more every time you'll taste it. Alc: 14.5%

FRONSAC

01-058-17 Chateau de la Riviere 2017

£30.99

Grapes: Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon and Malbec
A rich, concentrated red, showing blackberry and blackcurrant fruit, dark chocolate, and spice. Well structured with good length.
"89-91/100. Big, firm tannins add structure to rich fruit, this is dark and concentrated with hints of bitter chocolate and juicy acidity. This wine will age well, drink from 2022." (ROGER VOSS, Wine Enthusiast) Alc 14%

BLAYE

01-035 Chateau Puynard 2018

£20.99

Grapes: Merlot
A warm nose of aromas of sunny black fruits and stone fruits (plum & prune), accompanied by peppery scents. On the palate, it shows a beautiful overall harmony, an ample and fruity attack, an enveloped texture and a soft and savoury finish. Alc:14%

WHITE

01-600 Chateau Mont Saint Pey Blanc 2023 £11.99

Grapes: 65% Sauvignon Blanc, 35% Semillon

A wonderful modern zesty white with citrusy and grassy tones. Made from Sauvignon Blanc and Semillon this is juicy and great value. Alc 12%

01-500-20 Chateau Les Charmes Godard Blanc 2020 £22.99

Grapes: 54% Semillon, 23% Sauvignon Blanc, 23% Sauvignon Gris

A dry white wine that has proven its ability to age and compete with the great white Bordeaux wines. The core of the blend is made up of old vines, over 70 years old. Year after year, the young Sémillons of Laclaverie assert themselves and naturally take their place. The pre-dominance of Semillon as well as the vinification techniques (fermentation in barrels, maturing on lees) give the wine vivacity and roundness. Alc 13.5%

01-650-23 Chateau Puynard La Toile Blanc 2023 £24.99

Semillon & Colombard

La Toile is the first white wine ever produced at Château Puynard, from a blend Sémillon/Colombard. These two very different grapes complement each other perfectly in this cuvée, magnified by the ageing in Amphora. A dry white wine, with its brilliant straw yellow colour, has a nose of white flowers followed by aromas of pear and mirabelle plum. The palate is invigorating and full-bodied, finishing with aromas of tart berries and lemon. Alc 13.5%

01-655-22 Chateau Doisy Daene Blanc 2023 £30.99

Grapes: 100% Sauvignon Blanc

A Doisy wine was first mentioned in the "Topography of all Known Vineyards" written by André Jullien (1832) and was known for its sweet Barsac wines. The Doisy-Daëne Grand Vin Sec was first created in the 1950's.

This elegant, dry white is fresh and juicy with notes of peach, passionfruit, apple and mandarin. Alc 13%

55-001-18 Chateau Doisy Daene 2018

(37.5cl) £27.99

Grapes: 100% Semillon

A Doisy wine was first mentioned in the "Topography of all Known Vineyards" written by André Jullien (1832). Doisy growth was included among the twenty first classified Bordeaux white wines of which there are five.

A beautiful dessert wine with layers of honey and stone fruits. Rich and elegant with a long length.

"93/100. Stars of all styles of white wine in Bordeaux, the Dubourdieu family has produced a delicate, perfumed white. Apricot compote is layered with honey and acidity, giving the wine a fine lift. Textured and still young, the wine will be ready from 2025." Roger Voss, The Wine Enthusiast. Alc 13.5%

55-006-19 Chateau Coutet 2019

(37.5cl) £29.99

Grapes: 75% Sémillon, 23% Sauvignon Blanc, 2%, Muscadelle

"95-97/100. The pale lemon-gold colored 2019 Coutet is a thrill ride from the get-go, exploding from the glass with fantastically intense scents of tangerine peel, lime blossoms and lemon marmalade over a core of pineapple upside-down cake, candied ginger, ripe apricots and clover honey plus suggestions of chanterelles and musk perfume. The palate is equally electric and exhilarating, prancing around the palate with a whole myriad of candied citrus, stone fruit and citrus flavors, charged by a racy backbone of acidity, finishing beautifully textured and with an epically long firework display of minerals. Apart from all that, it is pretty darn delicious. 2025 - 2055." (Lisa Perrotti-Brown, Parker's Wine Advocate, Jul 09, 2020) Alc 13.5%



SAUTERNES

55-007 La Fleur d'Or Sauternes 2021

(37.5cl) £15.99

Grapes: Semillon, Sauvignon Blanc

La Fleur d'Or is a project started by Bill Blatch of Bordeaux negociant Vintex. Small batches of wines from lesser known Sauternes producers are blended with bits from some crus classes. An immediately inviting nose, combining apricot fruit, creamy patisserie notes and a certain citrus brightness, leads to a sweet yet beautifully balanced palate. Luscious but never cloying. Alc 13%

55-012-18 Clos Haut Peyraguey 2018(37.5cl) **£29.99**

Grapes: 97% Sémillon & 3% Sauvignon

Clos Haut-Peyraguey is the smallest of the 1st Grands Crus Classés de Sauternes in 1855. Its surface area is 8.5 ha, all in one piece within an enclosure, on the northeast slope of the property, opposite Château d'Yquem. It expresses notes of candied lemon, quince and more lightly candied apple associated with fine touches of candied mirabelle plum, marzipan, honey as well as very discreet hints of nutmeg and spices. A wine of finesse and elegance. *"94/100...deftly marries opulence with energy. Apricot jam, orange confit, marzipan, pineapple & mint in the glass...shows a touch more power than it did as a barrel sample. Even with all its richness, the 2018 shows quite a bit of vibrancy as well, and that makes for compelling drinking. 2024-2043."* (Antonio Galloni, Vinous, April 2021) Alc13.5%

55-004-18 Chateau Myrat 2021(37.5cl) **£24.99**
